## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

We have 3 packages:

- ✿ Sniper Pack – 100 Paintballs - \$30 per head
- ✿ Rambo Pack – 400 Paintballs - \$70 per head
- ✿ Terminator Pack – 700 Paintballs - \$125 per head
- ✿ Extra paintballs can be purchased with any pack for \$20 per 100
- ✿ All equipment and supervision is included in the prices.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

On arrival everyone signs in and is issued with camo overalls, ammo belt, paintballs and a safety mask. When everyone is kitted up the group will receive a detailed safety brief before being issued with their semi auto Paintball Gun. The group is split into 2 teams and given coloured arm bands. The Referee then escorts the group to the first playing field, conducts a gun demonstration and explains the rules of the game. Games last for around 10 to 15 minutes with breaks in between to re-hydrate and laugh about the last battle! Play as many games as you want on any of our 12 playing fields. If you require extra paintballs you can get them on the field at any time where they are recorded on your dog tags. When you have had enough for the day, its back to head quarters to return your equipment and hand in your Dog tags for payment. Feel free to unwind over a few drinks afterwards and relive past glories!

### WHAT DO I WEAR?

We suggest you wear loose fitting clothing or jeans, a t-shirt and outdoor shoes with good ankle support. All footwear must be enclosed. Full camouflage overalls are provided. You may bring a hat, scarf or gloves if you wish.

### HOW MANY PAINTBALLS WILL I USE?

This is entirely up to the individual. Most people use around 300 - 700 paintballs, so allow \$70-\$140 for an awesome day out.

### WHAT IS THE MINIMUM GROUP SIZE?

We have a minimum group size of 10; however we can combine smaller groups of a compatible age. Small Group Join-up times – Teens 0930 Adults 1330.

### CAN YOU ACCEPT LAST MINUTE BOOKINGS?

Yes. If you get the sudden urge to play paintball just give us a call and we will do our utmost to accommodate you.

### DO YOU SUPPLY LUNCH?

Soft drinks & snacks are available for sale at Headquarters and there are drinking fountains out on the field

## WHAT ABOUT RAIN OR HOT WEATHER?

As each of our playing fields has roofed safe areas that provide shade and protection from the rain, we can operate rain hail or shine. The Fleurieu Peninsula enjoys a cooler summer climate than Adelaide.

## HOW SAFE IS PAINTBALL?

## WHERE ARE WE?

Our Kuitpo field is located south of Adelaide off the Victor Harbor Road; about 25 minutes drive from the Southern expressway. Follow the Victor Harbor Road toward Mt. Compass. 6 km before Mt. Compass turn left onto Yundi Road. Follow the signs on Yundi road to the end and then turn left over the bridge. Follow this road for 3.5km. We are the first property on the right after the conservation park.
